As they have started college, they say that much of what they learned was true about their first days at college. Many were had become plugged into campus ministries through this. The result? Freshmen leading Freshmen to Christ, first day of college

Chelsea saw many of her older friends fall away from their faith in college. She was determined to not do the same. Through the website she found the Navigators at the University of Nebraska, a Christian roommate, and met the leaders and other students involved in the ministry over the summer. Her first night on campus, four girls in her dorm invited Chelsea and roommate to a party. Chelsea convinced them all to go to a Navigators hangout instead. Today all six are still in the Navigators and are strongly walking with Christ!

Dorm awakening at Freshmen Orientation

Most high school students have not had the life-changing experience of leading an unchurched friend to faith. Non-believing freshmen are tremendously open to new ideas and new friends. A student was radically converted during Freshmen orientation at Geneseo college in NY. The InterVarsity students saw how this student was completely set free, which encouraged them to partner with him and lead 26 other students to faith in that dorm that semester!

Preparing students for 7 Mountain Mission



Students don't want to just "go to church" any more. They want to plant multiplying movements of the gospel to influence culture in their dorms and academic departments. This experience translates to their future jobs.

- Help high school students select college majors in the context of 7M impact. Crown Financial Ministries Career Direct assists students and parents, through new Pinnacle Forum partner Jim Sullivan and partner John Scroggins from <u>Baton Exchange</u>.
- 2. Incoming freshmen create missional communities for their academic department for fellowship and to engage culture, and can partner with Christian professors. Change the campus, change the world.
- **3. This preparation helps them transition to the workplace.** The ESS network will provide continuity and a resume service. Baton Exchange is included in this network.






Every Student Sent - Goals

A similar loss happens in the transition from the university to the workplace.

- Reverse the 70% College Faith Drop-off by sending them with a team (proven in churches)
- Help our youth to disciple others especially among new freshmen during the <u>Fall Sweet Spot</u>
- Thereby doubling the number of active Christian Freshmen, and impact university culture
- Activate youth groups with success and transition testimonies of returning Freshmen.
- Triple the number of Kingdom-minded Christian College Grads, who can impact culture
- **Transition college grads to** business ministries, mentors, and churches to influence the "Seven Spheres Culture" in our Cities. <u>Pinnacle Forum and Baton Exchange</u> are teaming on this aspect.

2022 Scaling & Mobilization

At right is the investment needed to mobilize for 2022 to increase users from 15,000 to an estimated 51,000 and up. This is from a field of approximately 500,000 youth group grads per year. The goal is to reach a tipping point where the majority of Christian students (and their parents and pastors) start college with a team on mission rather than alone.






Efficiency of Investment

facilities cost:

- \$1,500 per year per student
- \$6,000 in high school
- \$12K+ for Grades 1-12

Sustainability

ESS will be self-sustaining within 3 Years

- **Will launch an online store** on ESS with various graduation and college prep related products in addition to video trainings, digital downloads
- **Donations.** Churches who have hosted their ESS listing at a University, plus those who want to put ESS into their mission budget. We have not started asking yet but already one has donated in excess of \$15,000 and another one is offering. Parents will be asked, and each student ESS user to will be asked to connect us with their parents. This will allow us to close the connection loop between parent and child as well as convert a percentage of the parents into donors or gift box service subscribers. As ESS becomes a normal process for college, the donor base will be quite large based on a service that is so close to the hearts of parents and leaders.
- Advertising revenue from the platform from selected organizations and Christian universities.
- Revenue from added service partners providing career services and college planning. Crown Financial Ministries Career Direct and College Assistance Plus are two of these partners so far.
- Will offer a monthly subscription gift box service for churches and parents to buy that sends a care package to a student each month which includes books, pre-paid digital Christian music downloads, spiritually themed movies, care items of general interest to college students, and custom video teaching content made by top Christian leaders exclusively for ESS. Recipients of the care packages will also have access to a monthly live web video conference featuring different influential Christians from various spheres of society to train them and answer their questions personally. It uses our ability to leverage our tremendous number of partners to create custom content not available anywhere else.


